Bonfires-do

bindweed; brambles; paper; couch grass; ground elder; hedge clippings; wood scraps; prunings from fruit trees & bushes

Bonfires-don't

metal; paint tins; glass; foam; plastic; rubber; aerosol cans; treated wood

Before lighting your bonfire – check for hibernating hedgehogs. Never leave a bonfire. You should supervise it until it is fully burnt out. If you must leave it, damp it down with plenty of water.

Planting New Fruit

Now is a good time to plant bare-rooted fruit bushes such as gooseberries and raspberries. They can be planted at any point during the dormant season of November to March. Soak the roots in water for 30 minutes before planting, add manure or compost to the planting hole, firm soil and water in ... Easy!
