PICK YOUR OWN

Have you had crops that you have lovingly looked after go missing from your plot? Have you spent days, weeks and months working on your plot to find that someone has picked your fruit or veg?

It is sad to say that we have some plot-holders who think it is okay to go onto other people's plots and help themselves to whatever takes their fancy!

Renting an allotment gives you the right to grow your own. It does not give you, or your guests, the right to venture onto other plots and steal produce.

Tenants who steal from other plot-holders will have their tenancy terminated.

In recent months many water tanks have developed leaks. Some of these have been caused by careless dipping of large buckets that have knocked pipes and valves. There has also been some contamination - please only dip clean watering cans into the tanks. You should never wash tools or other dirty items in the tanks. Please remember that the water in the tanks is for the sole use of watering crops.
